- Gujarat Gas Limited (GGL), the largest City Gas Distribution (CGD) Company in India, is making rapid strides in the CGD areas by launching an aggressive customer centric campaign. GGL has comprehensively transformed its strategy for industrial segment, with a customer centric vision focusing on customer convenience, awareness, faster response and automation of all processes so as to further penetrate the existing market and get customers on board. Pricing of Natural Gas, Tenure of the contract etc. which shall aid the customers in deciding the quantity.
- This arrangement is expected to be a mutually beneficial proposition for the customers and GGL. At present GGL supplies more than 4 mmscmd of Natural Gas to the Ceramic customers of Morbi & Surendranagar area and with this EoI, GGL expects to add 3 mmscmd of volume.
