Performance Highlights

The standalone Profit After Tax (PAT) for the current quarter was Rs. **117** crore compared to Rs 66 crore in the corresponding quarter last year showing a growth of **77%**.

The standalone PAT was Rs. **417** crore compared to Rs **291** crore in the previous year registering a growth of **43%**.

The Company added 63 new CNG stations in FY '19, highest ever in a year by the company. The Company commissioned first CNG station in Narmada GA in 4 months of receiving PNGRB license.

The company added close to 1 Lakh domestic connections and 300 industrial customers during FY19.

The National Green Tribunal has ordered on 6 March 2019 to ban the use of coal based gasifiers in Morbi, Gujarat. As a result of this order, the industrial sales volumes in Morbi have increased from mid-March 2019 and are currently flowing in the range of around 4.50+ mmscmd.

Gujarat Gas Limited(GGL), currently distributes approximately 8.5 mmscmd of natural gas. GGL continues to be India's largest gas distribution company in terms of sales volume, geographical spread and customer base. GGL distributes gas to about 13,55,000 domestic and 3540+ industrial. It has around 344 CNG retail outlets.
